

Reactive Robotics amongst the 10 winners of the Munich Business Plan Contest (Phase I)

Reactive Robotics is one of the ten winners in the first phase of Munich Business Plan Contest.

On March 3rd, ten high-tech startups have been awarded by BayStartUP, the organizer of the event which took place in the rooms of the Hypovereinsbank (HVB) Munich. 137 applicants submitted a short business plan for this round of the contest. Only 20 of these 137 applicants were invited for a 3-minute verbal stage presentation. Our CEO, Dr. Alexander König, convinced the jury, that the company vision as well as our business case is attractive for health care stakeholders and for potential investors.
